

Byways open to all traffic (BOATS) in the Yorkshire Dales National Park

Below is a list of the byways open to all traffic (BOATs) in the Yorkshire Dales National Park. These have proven vehicular rights and the use of motor vehicles on these routes is legal but requires special care to be taken by those undertaking the activity. Recreational motor vehicular uses should follow guidance from LARA and the TRF.
