Summary

Very large increase in population. (proportionately)

Increased population across the three age ranges.

*Substantial decline in household size from high base (largest reduction in the National Park)
More households of each type*

*Increased number of houses have been bought outright.
Also increased mortgage purchase and rental.*

9 tied houses (out of 14), have changed tenure.

Substantial increase in number of people economically active.

Main employment sectors are agriculture, hotels and catering. However, services are still well represented.

High proportion of managers.

Very high proportion work from home. Lower than average of car commuting.

Significant increase in the number of cars.

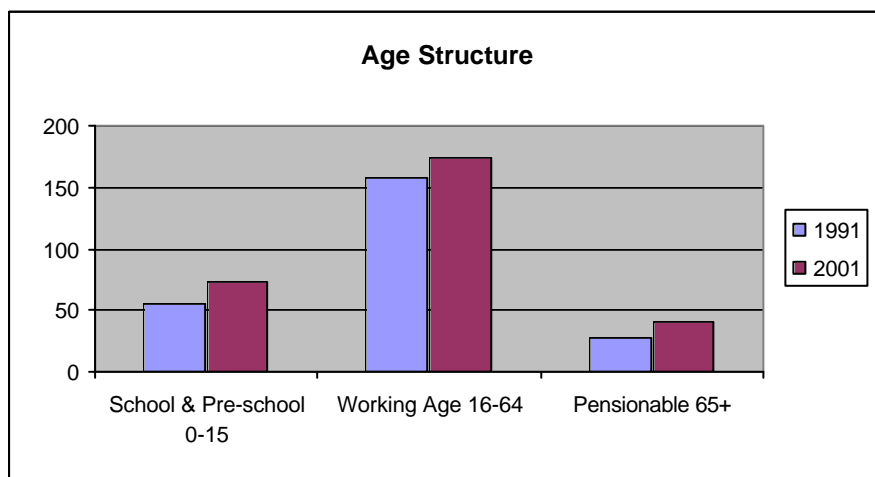
