

**YORKSHIRE DALES NATIONAL PARK AUTHORITY
(GORBECK ROAD PROHIBITION OF
MECHANICALLY PROPELLED VEHICLES)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2010**

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (as amended)

- 1 **NOTICE** is hereby given that the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority in exercise of its powers under section 22BB(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purposes of preserving the amenity and conserving the natural beauty of the area has made a Traffic Regulation Order, the effect of which is to prohibit access by mechanically propelled vehicles to the road more particularly described in paragraph 2.
- 2 **GORBECK ROAD**
The road known as Gorbeck Road from its junction with the classified road C393 at Langscar Gate (grid reference SD 8880 6488) in a westerly direction for approximately 6.5 kilometres to a point 100 metres to the east of the classified road C393 at Clay Pits Plantation (grid reference SD 8304 6523)
- 3 Exemptions are provided in the Order in relation to :
- (a) use by emergency services or by any local authority or water authority in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties.
 - (b) use to enable work to be carried out in or adjacent to that road.
 - (c) use for the purpose of conveying persons goods or merchandise to or from land or premises adjacent to that road.
 - (d) use for the purposes of agriculture, land management or shooting on any land or premises adjacent to that road.
 - (e) use by recognised invalid carriage
- 4 The Order will come into operation on 23rd August 2010.

- 6 Any person who wishes to question the validity of the above Order or of any of the provisions of the Order on the ground that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with, may, within six weeks of the date when the Order was made apply to the High Court for that purpose.
