(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS)

**(BRIDLEWAY NO.21 (PART) HIGH ABBOTSDALE)
ORDER 2010 No. 2**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

Notice is hereby given that the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any person from proceeding along Bridleway No. 21 in the Parish of High Abbotside, in the District of Richmondshire from grid reference SD 8328 9425 for approximately 1.1km north to the point where the bridleway exits the forest plantation at grid reference SD 8364 9484 from 9 March 2010 until 3 September 2010 inclusive.

The Order is necessary due to works being executed on or near the route, namely timber harvesting.

The closure will be put into effect when necessary by means of the erection of notices and signs. It is envisaged that the works will be undertaken within six months.

The alternative route to be used during the closure period will be as follows:-

From point of closure at SD 8328 9425, proceed generally south for approximately 200 metres, to the junction with the County road in Cotterdale hamlet, continuing south along this road for approximately 2.6km, crossing two cattle grids to the junction with the A684 at grid reference SD 8419 9211. Turn east for approximately 2 km along the A684, to the junction with the Hardraw road at grid reference SD 8573 9103. Continue east for approximately 1km towards Hardraw, to the bridleway finger post on the roadside at grid reference SD 8665 9118. Turn north along the bridleway, rising uphill and passing through two field gates, to the junction with the Pennine Way at SD 8473 9324. Continue north, north west along the bridleway for approximately 2km to the top of the forest plantation and point of closure at grid reference SD 8364 9484, and return.
