(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS)

**(FOOTPATH NO. 568049 (PART), SEDBERGH)
ORDER 2010 NO. 4**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

Notice is hereby given that the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any pedestrian from proceeding along part of Footpath No. 568049 from point of closure at Grid Reference SD 6526 9205 for approximately 240 metres to Grid Reference SD 6521 9226 in the Parish of Sedbergh, in the District of South Lakeland from 12 July 2010 until 11 January 2011 inclusive.

The Order is necessary because works are being executed on or near the road namely carrying out works required to repair and upgrade the surface of the footpath.

The closure will be put into effect when necessary by means of the erection of notices and signs. It is envisaged that the works will be undertaken within two weeks.

The alternative route to be used during the closure period will be as follows:-

From point of closure at Grid Reference SD 6521 9226, at an open gap on Footpath No. 568049 proceed north for approximately 40 metres to Howgill Lane at Grid Reference SD 6521 9230. Proceed east on Howgill Lane for approximately 212 metres towards Sedbergh. At Grid Reference SD 6542 9230 proceed south along a path and then pavement for approximately 300 metres along Woodside Avenue to its junction with Station Road at Grid Reference SD 6539 9204. Follow Station Road south west for approximately 117 metres to its junction with footpath No. 568049 at Grid Reference SD 6529 9198. Turn north along Footpath No. 568049 for approximately 65 metres to point of closure at a Field Gate / Kissing Gate at Grid Reference SD 6526 9205 and return.
