

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS)  
(FOOTPATH NO. 53 (PART) ARKENGARThDALE & 17 (PART) REETH)  
ORDER 2009 No. 6**

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14(1) (As Amended)**

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order made by the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority on 22 December 2009 the effect of which is to prohibit any pedestrian from proceeding along part of Footpath No. 53 in the Parish of Arkengarthdale in the District of Richmondshire and Footpath No.17 in the Parish of Reeth in the District of Richmondshire for a distance of approximately 80 metres between Grid Reference NZ 0169 0201 and Grid Reference NZ 0176 0197 from 22 December 2009 until 1 June 2010 inclusive, due to works being executed on or near the route, has been continued in force, under Section 15(5) of the above Act, with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, Local Government and the Regions for a period of 6 months until 1 December 2010.

The closure will be continued in effect by the erection of notices and signs.

The alternative route to be used during the closure is as follows:-

From the point of closure west of the bridge at grid reference NZ 0169 0201 continue west for approximately 350m until you join the stone track/bridleway in Booze Wood. The junction is indicated by a timber finger post. Turn immediately east and continue eastward along the track for approximately 440m towards Storethwaite Hall Farm until you reach a ford and footbridge crossing Slei Gill. Cross Slei Gill and continue east then south east along the track until you reach a metal field gate just south of Storethwaite Hall Farm. Continue through the gateway and along the bridleway for approximately 300m, crossing grazing meadows until you reach Arkle Beck at a point immediately west of a timber footbridge. Turn west on to the riverside footpath and continue west then north west along the footpath for approximately 400m to the point of closure at grid reference NZ 0176 0197 and return.
