	NYCC Highway Officer	The Highway Engineer has verbally confirmed that NYCC has no objection to the use of the access from Waters Side Lane.

	Agent	The agent has confirmed that they will discharge all the foul water into a package treatment plant (Klargester), the surface water will go into a herringbone soakaway details of which are to be provided.
