

Gargrave Neighbourhood Development Plan Regulation 19 Decision Statement September 2019

(Section 38A(9) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended)
Regulations 19 and 20 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended)

In line with Regulation 19 above the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority is issuing this 'Decision Statement' in relation to the Gargrave Neighbourhood Development Plan.

The Plan successfully passed its referendum, held on Thursday 30th May 2019.

The Gargrave Neighbourhood Plan lies across the National Park boundary and therefore both Craven District Council and the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority are bringing it into force as part of the statutory development plan up to 2032.
